

## **KEY**

Pergola - a breezy shelter and support for vines.

Annual growing beds - we grow most of our vegetables here and use crop rotation and organic systems.

Bulk storage - a place to collect manure, woodchip, leafmould.

Yard - vehicle access, plant nursery and wood store.

Container - storage for hand tools, gloves, DIY, carpentry etc.

Polytunnel - a sheltered indoor space for tender veg eg tomatoes, chillies, cucumbers etc.

Hugel mounds - log filled earth mounds supporting diverse perennial planting.

Cob oven - woodfired pizza /bread oven

Cabin -information and library plus tea making

Shelter - field kitchen, washing up and main dining area.

Loo - a urine separating compost toilet.

Water harvesting - catching and storing rainfall from roof in large tanks.

Central area - for events, screenings, bonfires, socials etc

Composting - cycling of garden waste into re useable organic matter. We turn the waste on a regular basis to encourage quick breakdown of woody materials.

Forest garden - an edible, productive woodland following natural growth patterns and cycles.

Chicken coop - home to laying hens.

Apiary - home to bees in national, warre and top bar hives.

Wilderness - remains of the sites previous use as a dump. Now a haven for birds and foxes.
